

### BEACH CLUB RIPRAP AND PATHWAY COMPLETION: ENHANCING COASTAL ACCESS AND PROTECTION







We are pleased to announce the successful completion of two important projects at the Beach Club: the **Beach Club Riprap** and the **Beach Pathwalk**. These developments represent significant advancements in both the preservation and accessibility of our coastal environment.

The newly installed Beach Club Riprap serves as a vital structural enhancement to protect the shoreline from erosion. This project involved the careful placement of durable rocks along the beach's edge, reinforcing the natural defenses against the impact of waves and weather.
